BRAND HISTORY

- Established in 1991 by Dominique Massenez, a Frenchman who left his family distillery in Alsace behind to start a winery in the prestigious Cachapoal Andes Valley of Chile
- After working to bring electricity, roads, and telephones to the region, Chateau Los Boldos was born using young European oenologist trainees, German and Spanish migrant workers, and specialized equipment from Alsace
- The winery is 100% Sustainable certified by Wines Of Chile in the Vineyard, Winery, and Social Responsibility categories
- The winery has 175 planted hectares with Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Merlot, Carménère, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, and recently Touriga Nacional, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc



THE WINE

- VARIETIES: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- WINEMAKING: Sourced from 15-year-old vines in the Cachapoal Andes Valley. After crushing, the grapes are transferred to stainless steel tanks, where they are held for five days at low temperatures. The grapes then undergo malolactic fermentation for 25 days at 77-79 °F to give the wine a rich and creamy texture.
- AGING: Aged in French oak barrels for 10 months
- TASTING NOTES: Intense ruby red color with fruit aromas of cherries, plums, black currants, and a touch of leather and smoke. This wine is balanced with a medium body, round tannins, and a persistent ending.
- PAIRINGS: This wine is very food-friendly. Pairs well with roasted or grilled red meats and is excellent with spicy Asian dishes.
- ABV: 14% | TA: 3.23 g/l | RS: 1.94 g/l | PH: 3.56
